1st Election of tellers for this GV

Hannah Falk starts the GV by welcoming everyone. She introduces the concept of the GV. Then, two tellers have to be elected. Chantal Weibel and Anna Wimberger offer to be tellers and they will be unanimously accepted by everyone with a quorum.

2nd Approval of agenda points

Hannah Falk introduces the agenda points that were already sent to all UFO-members in advance. The agenda points will be unanimously accepted.

3rd Approval of last GV's minutes

The protocol of the last GV meeting 20.10.2022 will be accepted. One person abstains, the rest are in favour.

4th Announcements from UFO board

Each board member comes to the front and briefly introduces themselves. Board members representing the UFO commissions will introduce themselves and their commission in their respective agenda points.

5th Approval of interim elections

5th1st Board members

Sofie Stade from the AFK, Casimir Herold from the PK and Mario Wildhaber the TdBK. Were elected ad interim by the UFO board before the GV. Now, they have to be elected at the GV. The ones present of the three, Mario Wildhaber and Casimir Herold, introduce themselves. They will be unanimously accepted as board members.

5th2nd Extraordinary members

Next up, Hannah Falk says that Vitus Woge wanted to become an extraordinary member two hours after the last GV. However, our current statutes only allow election of an extraordinary member during a GV. Nonetheless, the board elected Vitus Woge ad interim as an extraordinary member after the last GV so he wouldn't have to wait an entire semester to become one. Hannah also says that the statutes regarding this and various other points will be reworked in the next semester. Vitus Woge was unanimously accepted as an extraordinary member.





6th Budget 2022/23

Hannah Falk hands the microphone over to Lukas Wirth and Nik Zimmerli, the two coaccountants of the UFO. Lukas presents agenda point 6.1 and goes through the slide. The biggest expense that is still pending is the Summer PVK, which usually costs 20'000 CHF.

Lukas Wirth then announces that they had to fill out the taxes starting from 2016. Nik Zimmerli and he completed them to their best of their knowledge which was required some effort since not everything has been documented well since 2016. Lukas goes on stating that they applied to be exempt from taxes, however since the UFO is mostly for students and not for everyone, it cannot be viewed as charitable. Thus, the canton denied the application.

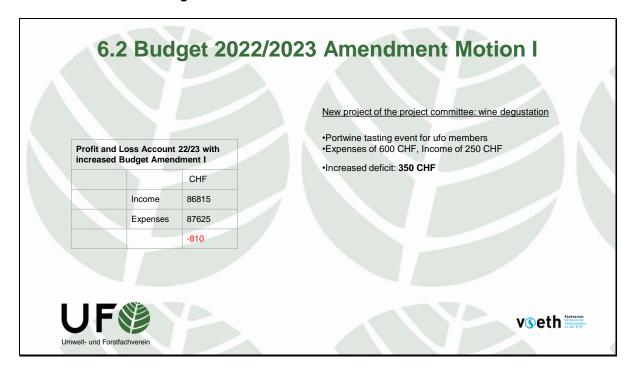

Lukas Wirth responds: "They also wanted to be charitable and since that was unlikely, they decided to sue themselves. They managed to save 30'000 CHF in taxes for that.

Amendment 1: Wine degustation of the PK

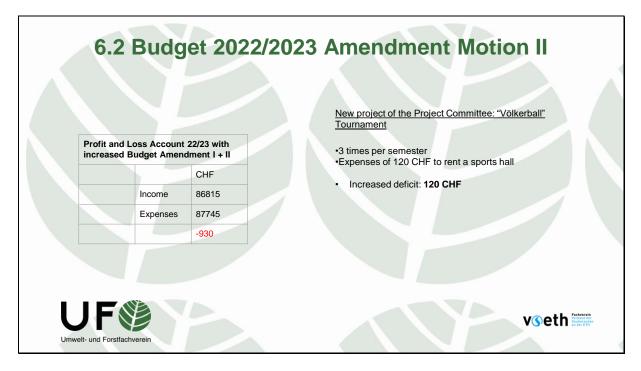


Chantal Weibel asks: "How high will the uncredited expenses be?" Lukas Wirth responds: "Smaller than expected so there will still be a profit. We saved 4000.- specifically for the taxes and if they are not that high, we'll have even more profit." Chantal Weibel finalizes: "So we might have around 3000.- left all in all." Lukas Wirth agrees with Chantal Weibel. The amendment motion will be unanimously approved.



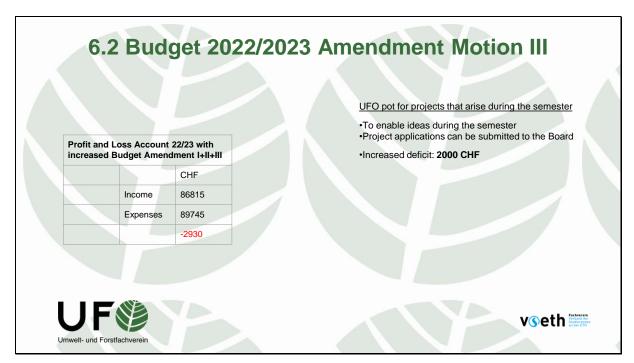


Amendment 2: Völkerball

Amendment 3: UFO pot

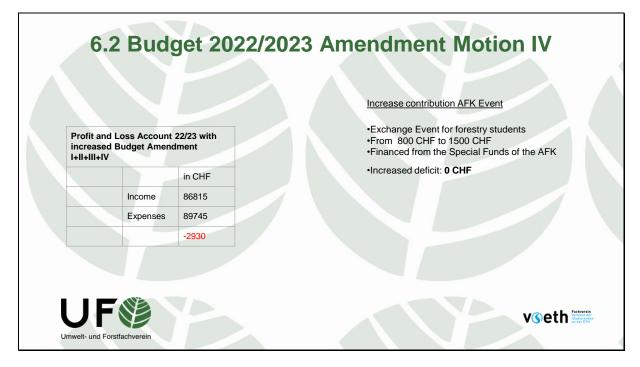

Amendment 4: Increase contribution to AFK Events



They explain that this does not change the UFO deficit since the contribution will be made from the AFK's Special Funds Budget. The amendment motion will be unanimously approved.

Overall, the new budget will be with an income of 86'815.- and an expense of 89'745.- which results in a deficit of -2'930.-. A more detailed version of the budget will be distributed as a pdf next week.

7th Exoneration of board

The exoneration of the board was unanimously accepted.

8th Election of UFO Board FS23

Laura Schnegg welcomes the two new Co-Presidents: Virginia Hart and Yitao Li. They introduce themselves. Laura Schnegg then continues with the other board members. Jannis Portman introduces the new UFO fileserver. Features of the new server include being able to upload any file, rate/like files, report issues with files, easily search for files and courses, login with nethz-account and light/dark modes. Then, Jannis gives everyone a short overview of how it looks like. Jannis does remind everyone that the Fileserver is still in the testing environment.

Afterwards Jannis Portmann shows the Roadmap for the Fileserver: In the upcoming weeks Jannis will send an email to everyone so that they can test the server and give feedback on it. The goal is that the Fileserver will be ready in May 2023, just before the exam season starts.

Questions:

Jimmy Kochuparampil: "Will the Fileserver be only accessible to UFO members?" Jannis Portmann: "Until it proves to be a bad idea the Fileserver will be accessible to everyone." Casimir Herold: "How difficult is it to maintain that server." Jannis Portmann: "The whole server was written with Python. Other student organisations use the same framework so they could assist us if any big problems arise. The VSETH IT people could also support us if necessary."
